



## Mrs. Alfonsina "Alice" Sedita

January 24, 1912 - July 26, 2013

Alfonsina, (nee Ragona) Sedita, of Huntington Station, passed away peacefully on July 26, 2013, surrounded by her loving family. "Alice" was born in Boston on January 24, 1912, grew up in Manhattan, and made the bold decision to move to Italy in the late 1930's where she met and married Luigi Sedita, who served as the Head of Weights and Measures for the Tuscany Region. They had two children, Sergio and Beatrice, and lived in Mantova, Udine and then Florence. While in Italy, Alice served as a translator for the allied forces after World War II, being fluent in English and Italian. The family moved to New York City in 1949 and to Brooklyn in 1953. When she returned to the States, "Alice" resumed her career with Macmillan Publishing Company where she retired as a Manager of Inventory Control at age 70. "Alice" had a rich and full life, enjoying travel and an active social life. Her outgoing personality and interest in people and things made it easy for her to acquire a wide circle of friends. Over the year she was active in a variety of social organizations, including the Melville Unit, St. Hugh's senior group, and singing with the Sweet Adelines. However, nothing brought her more pleasure than spending time with her family. There was a joyful celebration of her 100th birthday in January 2012 at the Harbor Club in Huntington where over 185 people joined in the festivities. Alice lost her beloved husband, Luigi, in 1989 and her precious grandson Court, on 2002. She will be sadly missed by her son, Sergio Sedita, her daughter-in-law, Priscilla Sedita, her daughter Beatrice Cronin, her granddaughter, Lisa Demas, and her great grandsons, Clay and
