Alice was born in her home, on the family farm in East Northport, New York on May 1, 1914. Alice grew up on the farm, attended the local schools, graduating from Northport High School in 1932. She was a wife, a mother of 1, an aunt to 5, a Grand Aunt to 7, and a Great Aunt to 8. Among many notable events, she spoke of watching Charles Lindbergh take off from Long Island and fly "the Spirit of St. Louis" to Paris. During World War 2, Alice worked as a riveter, working for Grumman Aviation, building various aircraft used in the war effort. She spent her life working and living on the family farm. She worked hard while being kind and generous to all. She had some fun! Alice recently said, "Look at me. At 99 years old, I am living in the same house I grew up as a child. We had no electricity and no running water, but I sit here today watching HDTV."
