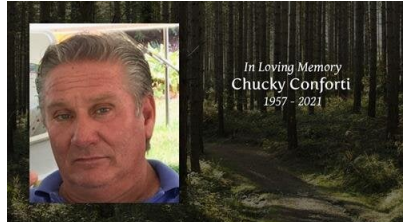

I always enjoyed seeing Chuckie as a kid when I was growing up on the island. He was about 8 years older than me. I was thinking back today about him and I can remember him coaching my T ball team at the Huntington YMCA in the early 70's. It's hard to recall but I think he was coaching Dana and I.

When I was growing up in Melville Chuckie would come occasionally to help my dad (Vinnie) around the property. I can still see him driving up with uncle Charlie's green stake body Ford pickup truck. I can remember one Saturday when he split what had to be an entire cord of firewood non stop with a splitting sledge and a wedge. He turned it into a game and he kept yelling Macho Comocho! Who he had to explain to me was a famous boxer at the time.

I can still remember right where he was working next to our dog kennel.

Over the years I would see him occasionally when he would stop by my dad's shop to visit.
