On Wednesday, December 2, 2020, Christine Marie Pisani of Huntington, NY, loving parent of two stepchildren and grandmother of five, passed away at age 71.

Christine was born on August 27, 1949 to Alfred and Virginia Pisani of Plainfield, New Jersey. She graduated from the College of Mount St. Vincent with a bachelors in French language and literature. Christine then went on to receive her M.B.A. in finance from Fordham University's Gabelli School of Business before becoming an executive assistant at Russell Reynolds Associates.
