Constant Joseph “Connie” Prokop, 91, of Brookline, Massachusetts, passed away peacefully on November 7, 2025, after a long and remarkable life defined by hard work, determination, laughter, and most of all, love.

Born and raised in New York, Connie graduated from the United States Merchant Marine Academy at King’s Point and went on to earn his master’s degree from Hofstra University.
