



Dale Ketcham Graves

May 16, 1942 - January 13, 2023

Dale Ketcham Graves of Halesite passed away peacefully in her home on January 13

surrounded by family.

She was a direct descendant of William Rogers, a signer of the deed for the purchase

of Huntington Townsite in 1656.

Dale, or 'GG' as she came to be known, was born on May 16, 1942 to Captain and

Mrs F. Rogers Ketcham. A World War II baby, her early years were spent in Halesite

with her mother and great grandmother while her father was away in the Coast

Guard.

Like her father, she loved being on the water. She spent summers with her parents

and siblings sailing to Newport, Block Island and Montauk. She was a skilled sailor

and during her teenage years worked as an instructor at the Huntington Yacht Club.

She attended Nathan Hale and East Woods School in Oyster Bay, and then high

school at Concord Academy. She graduated from Manhattanville College in

1964.

After college, she took a job at the Hubschman Fund in New York City where she

became a Vice-President. Later in her career, she commuted daily from Long Island to

New York City to her job as a Commodity Trader at REFCO.

She was involved in her local community, volunteering at Huntington Hospital and

attending daily Mass. She also enjoyed playing Bridge and Canasta with her dear

friends. She was especially blessed to have these friends, as well as her family by her

side when she was diagnosed with ALS in February 2022. It was an incredibly difficult

situation which she handled with strength and grace.

Family was always Dale's priority. She is survived by her children, Hillary Graves

Brown (Dean) and Paul T. Graves II (Ruthie), her beloved grandchildren, Montgomery

Graves Brown, Ridley Ketcham Brown and Ford Ketcham Graves, as well as her

siblings, F. Rogers Ketcham Jr. and Kathleen K. Wikowitz, and her nieces, nephew and

their families.

Funeral Mass was celebrated on January 21 at St Patrick's Church in Huntington, with
