May all of you be comforted by memories so many of us have of your wonderful Father. May he Rest In Peace.

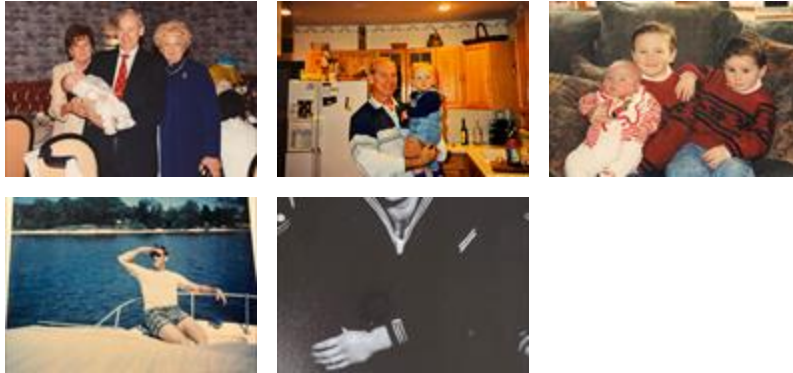

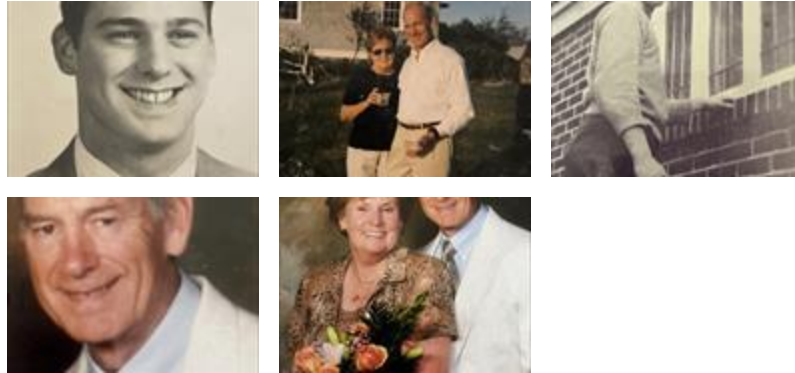

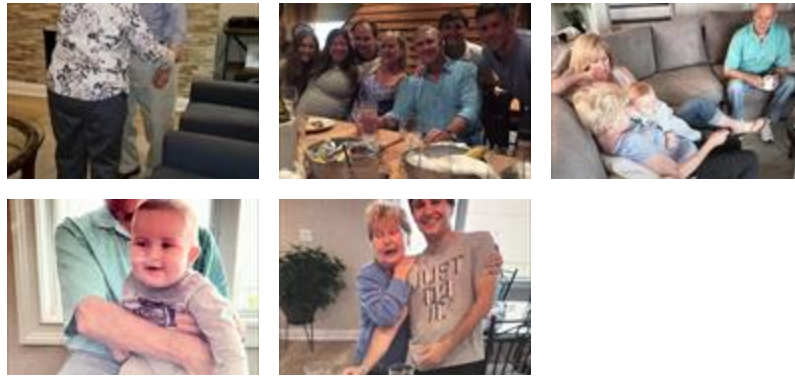
