Edward LaRochelle sadly passed away on May 4, 2026, at the age of 54.

Edward was born in Queens and spent part of his adolescence in Ebbets Field, Brooklyn before moving to Cambria Heights in 1976.

Edward was truly a gentle soul. Kind, thoughtful, creative, and deeply loved by those who knew him. He had a lifelong passion for comic books, film, science fiction, and storytelling. A devoted fan of the New York Knicks, New York Mets, and New York Giants, Edward also found great joy in the worlds of Star Wars and The Lord of the Rings. His knowledge and enthusiasm for the Star Wars universe were unmatched, and he eagerly looked forward to attending conventions across the country, including trips to Anaheim for Star Wars celebrations. He also loved attending New York Comic Con and anime conventions, where he connected with the communities and stories he cherished so much.

Edward attended Saints Joachim and Anne elementary school in Queens Village before graduating from Thomas A. Edison High School. He later

attended Borough of Manhattan Community College, where his passion for media and television continued to grow. He began his professional career through an internship at CUNY TV and was later hired full-time as a Master Control Operator, a role he proudly held for more than 30 years.

Edward loved his family immensely and took great pride in his work and relationships. Though he never married or had children of his own, he was a second father to Trevor and Stella and played an important role in the lives of all his nieces and nephews. He had a warm sense of humor, a gentle presence, and a way of making people smile through the simple things he would say and do. He will be deeply missed by his family, friends, colleagues, and all who had the privilege of knowing him.
