Guy was a very good student at math, and his teachers said Guy could have been an engineer or math teacher. But Guy loved acting, and was determined to do it his way, like the Frank Sinatra song "My Way". Guy and I were friends as young teenagers, and Guy often ate dinner with my family (Guy had a big appetite), slept over, partied with us during Christmas (Guy was a big partyer), and worked with my dad (Guy was a great worker) and I on the Christmas tree lots on Long Island, and celebrated Christmas eve at our house. Guy was a lot of fun, very honest, highest integrity, and a zest for life. Guy always did it his way! Guy and I were also born on the same day, January 10, and often celebrated our birthdays together which usually involved a lot of partying, and one year, a Grateful Dead concert at MSG in 1978 when we turned 18 years old.

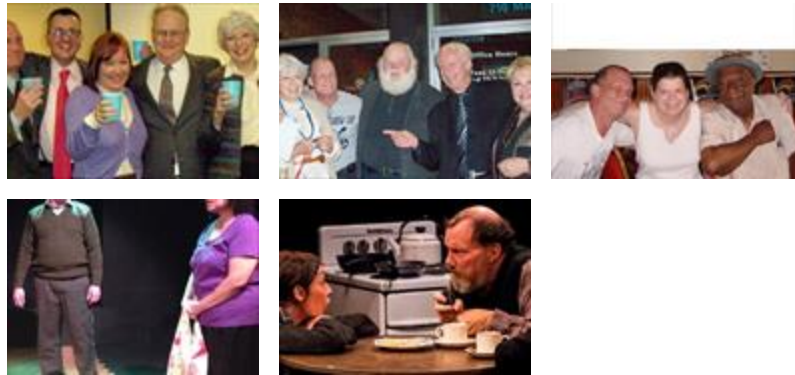
