November 26, 1928 - December 26, 2012

Born to Anna Panny, and John Heigl, in North Hampton, Pennsylvania, Ida spent her early childhood years loving nature and the outdoors, especially her time in upstate New York, where the Panny farm was located. She spent most of her years however, on Long Island, married to Edward Colucci. She grew up mostly in New York and had four siblings; John and Len, her brothers and Annie and Irene, her sisters. Many years were spent in one house at 14 Frostfield Place, Melville, New York. There she raised a family and made a home for her husband and her sons, Edward and Randall. Years later, after her children were grown and married, she moved to Florida, north of Tampa in Hudson, spending many years there surrounded by her family including John and Hilda Heigl, Ann and Walter Stark, John and Lillian Stark, and Len and Lallie Heigl. With the passing of time and family around her passing as well, Ida moved north to live with her son Randall, outside of Columbus, Ohio, and then several years with her other son Edward outside of Denver, Colorado, until she passed on December 26, 2012. Ida was 84 years and 1 month old when she left us and this world. She loved her family dearly, both immediate and extended as well as her true friends which included her canine companions throughout her life. she insisted on being buried with the cremated remains of her last dog, Taffy. She was buried on January 3rd, 2013, with her husband Edward, at St. Charles Cemetery, in East Farmingdale, New York.
