“ I would like to say a few words in remembrance of the love of my life, my wife Jean. We met 56 years ago when we were bought living in Franklin Square, and we just started out as just good friends. That didn't seem to work out too good, so instead we got married and spent the next 51 years happily together. We were both so happy when we bought our first house in West Hempstead. It was one of the many highlights of our life together, raising our 3 children there having wonderful neighbors, buying furniture and decorating our home, having lots of parties and my pride and joy landscaping my house. Jeannie was a tough woman and didn't hesitate to tell you like it is. That was her on the outside, but inside she was loving, caring and never really meant anything she said. She loved family and friends and would go out of her way to express that with them. She was the happiest woman in the world when we bought our condo in Florida, and she couldn't wait to start decorating it, which she was an artist at. Everybody would ask her advise on how to fix their place and she would enjoy helping them and pitching in to do the actual work. She was a woman who loved to entertain and have company, and whoever we invited knew it was going to be a special night, because she was a great cook and a perfect hostess. She loved Easter, Thanksgiving and X-mas because she knew it was a time when our children and grandchildren were all going to be together. She loved cooking and baking which she was very good at, because I was very hard to please. She loved shopping and one of her favorite stores was HomeGoods where she would spend hours browsing and buying, shopping for bargains and sale items. She wasn't too much on traveling, but was content with simple things like going out to dinner, visiting with friends and family and weekend getaways. We always wanted the best for our children and whatever we planned or they had planned we always put a lot of thought and effort into it so everything would turn out perfect. Our life together was a good one, but being married so long we had our ups and downs like everybody else, but we always seemed to work it out, because deep down we loved each other very much and when there is love that overcomes everything. Our life was a good one except for the last year when she spent more time in hospitals and

rehab centers than she was at home. But one thing about jeannie as you all know she was a fighter and somehow endured all the pain and suffering, and the time away from family and friends. The prior 5 years, she stood up and faced every challenge and always came out on top. This past month in the fight of her life everything caught up to her all at once and what so many obstacles in her way to get by she had no choice but to give up the battle. All her treatment options ran out and she told me and my children she couldn't live like this anymore. The last 2 weeks before she passed away I lived at the hospital in Manhattan on a cot right next to her, trying to comfort her through her suffering, as best as I could. I let her know how much everybody loved her, telling her all the good times we had and although she wasn't that alert I knew she heard me by little signs that she gave me. She passed away Sunday night with me and my children by her bedside expressing our love to her and then with one more glance at us and one final gasp, God took her home to a beautiful place where there is no pain or suffering only love and peace. We are going to be apart for a while, but someday we will all be together again sharing all the love and good times we had during our lifetime. I want to say again jeannie loved all her family and all the good friends she made during her lifetime. She was 72 years old but people would not believe she was that old and the way she faced each day young at heart. When jeannie passed away I was devastated and really did not have the will to go on after being married to her for so long, but I thank my children that they made me realize she is walking right next to us all and watching over us, a
