Born at home at 149 Blackrock Avenue in Bridgeport, Connecticut, Joe lived a full colorful life.

Founder of the Roger Cullen Band, he played at the first World's Fair in 1939. He graduated from Brooklyn Poly Tech and went on to become an Aerospace Engineer, who worked on the early development of Radar. Joe Weiss was a democratic committee man in Huntington for over 40 years.

He is survived by Leslie A. Weiss, of Cold Spring Harbor, and Cully Weiss, of Wilmington, NC. He and his sense of humor and wit will be greatly missed.
