



## Louise Dougher

September 21, 1919 - November 21, 2014

Louise Logan Dougher was the daughter of John and Helen Nye Logan of Oneonta N.Y. She graduated from Oneonta High and SUNY Oneonta and also attended the University of Wisconsin.

Her first job was a teacher in a one room school near Cooperstown later teaching at schools in Berne, Cobleskill and Tappan N.Y.

In 1946 she married Ronald Dougher, a professor at SUNY Farmingdale who predeceased her.

Louise was instrumental in founding the Greenlawn-Centerport Historical Association and served as its first director for 14 years. She also co-authored the book Greenlawn, a Long Island Hamlet, helped start the annual Pickle Festival and helped save and restore the Suydam House.

She is survived by son Michael Dougher and wife Debbie of Chattanooga TN and son Robert (Yogi) Dougher and wife Kimberly, grandsons Jacob and Logan Dougher all of Nashville TN.
