Marie (?Rie?) P. Baum of Greenport, formerly of Huntington, died December 15. She was 86 years old.

Rie grew up in East Elmhurst with her parents, four brothers, and a sister. Happy summers were spent in Jamesport. Rie was a graduate of Mary Lewis Academy and Endicott Junior College. She worked for Arthur Godfrey's radio show as a young woman. After World War II, she married her fiancé Bill (William A. Baum Jr.). They lived in the Bronx and Levittown before settling in Huntington.

Rie and Bill were featured as typical post-War suburbanites in a Newsday article, later collected in the book Long Island: Our History. While raising four children, Rie was a tireless volunteer in her parish and for organizations such as the Family Service League. She was an enthusiastic golfer at the Huntington Country Club and a regular at the YMCA pool. In 2010, she and Bill moved to Peconic Landing in Greenport. Rie is survived by Bill, her husband of 65 years; her brother Al; her children William (?Buzz?) and his wife Geri, Christopher (?Kit?), Lucy and her husband John, and Elyse and her husband Michael; and five grandchildren, as well as many nieces and nephews.

A wake will be held at A.L. Jacobson's Tuesday Dec. 20th 2-4 p.m. and 7-9 p.m. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 9:45 a.m. on Wed. December 21st at
