



Roberta Lee Bernstein

March 19, 1933 - August 1, 2016

Roberta Lee Bernstein, age 83, died in Lake Worth, Florida, on August 1. Roberta was previously a long-time resident of Huntington Station, NY, having grown up on Pulaski Road.

Born on March 19, 1933 to Morris and Jean (Kalt) Goldstein, she graduated from Huntington High School in 1951 where she was active in cheerleading and dance. Shortly after high school graduation she met her future husband Ted, who grew up on a dairy farm in the Dix Hills section of Huntington. They resided for over 30 years at their home on the corner of West Park Drive and Depot Road before she moved to California and later Florida.

She had fond memories and many stories about growing up at the Goldstein Brothers' Junk Yard owned by her father and her Uncle Paul, a business started by her grandfather Isaac Goldstein around 1908. In later years, every July 4th, she would take her young children to the yard for a cookout with extended family and to sit on top of the old cars for a great view of the fireworks display at Manor Field.

An excellent cook, she was equally adept at whipping up matzah ball soup or eggplant parmigiana. She enjoyed family trips to the Amish country in Pennsylvania, partying with the Phi Psi brothers at Cornell, shopping at swap meets in California and attending horse shows in Florida and Europe.

She was predeceased by her husband Ted in 2004. Surviving are her three

children, Barry Bernstein (Peggy) of Nashville, Tennessee, Darlene Theodorakis (Mario) of Huntington, New York, and Craig Bernstein (Keena) of Stuart, Florida; two grandchildren, Thomas Bernstein (Betsy) of Nashville, and Sarah Eklund (Andrew), of Hoboken, New Jersey; one great-grandchild, Sally Bernstein, of Nashville; her sister Eileen Popkin, of West Hills, California; and several nieces, grand-nieces and grand-nephews.
