"Yesterday, on the last day of 2015, a woman who opened her home to me and many other kids during the late 1960s and into the very early 70s, was waked at her home-going celebration by her very accomplished, elegant daughter, Adrienne Renee Workman, and the rest of her welcoming, loving children, grandchildren, other family and friends. I met Mrs. Workman in 1968, when her son, Paul Workman, who is now gone as well, invited me, my boyfriend and a few of our friends from school back to his house to listen to music and to continue a very lively conversation about how we could stop the racism in our town. From that day through high school graduation, the Workman's home was a life-saving retreat for me... an escape from the painful, manic intensity my own mother inserted into everyday life... and for so many other young people who found shelter in her company and her home. I did not know that she taught at Stagecoach Elementary School in Middle Country School District until 1986, where I am confident thousands of other children benefited from her kindness, imagination, inclusiveness and love for young people of all ages. I am so happy that Adrienne is also a teacher who adores her first graders, and that Adrienne's daughter is doing her residency as an ob/gyn, where she will influence the lives of children in a whole new and wonderful way. Maggie Spring, thank you for letting me know Mrs. Workman had passed. You were most definitely there in spirit. I expect 2016 and years to come to present more opportunities to pick up this long-neglected friendship, to get to know Eric and his children better, maybe to work a bit with Adrienne and get to know her daughter, son and grandchildren better... so we can find new ways to continue what started with such open minds and hearts so many years ago."
