Wayne P. English, of Selden, NY, died peacefully as a result of cancer on October 21, 2020. He was 57.

Born on December 22 to Frank English and Geraldine (Miles) English, Wayne grew up in West Hills and was a lifelong resident of Long Island.

Wayne followed in his father's footsteps as an ironworker in Local 361. During his 31-year career he proudly worked on some of the most recognizable constructions in the New York metro area, including JFK, LaGuardia, and the Barclays Center. Wayne was also a member of the team that installed the spire atop One World Trade Center, and keenly recalled that its peak reached a height of 1,776 feet.

Wayne is survived by his children Taylor and Garret, brother Shane, sister Renee (Michael) DeDora, nephew Michael (Jean), and niece Rachel (Tootsie).
