



William A. Baum Jr.

June 4, 1919 - November 8, 2013

William A. Baum, Jr. of Greenport, formerly of Huntington, died November 7. Bill was 94.

Bill grew up in East New York and Forest Hills with his parents and five brothers. His college years at Notre Dame were interrupted by his service in World War II. Bill was a major in the Army, stationed in Bombay, India. After the war, he married his fiancé Marie Tèrese Perrine, and joined his family's firm. The W. A. Baum Company had been started by Bill's father when he patented a special type of blood pressure instrument in 1916. While working and starting a family, Bill finished his college degree. He graduated from New York University in 1952. Around that same time, Bill and "Rie" moved out from Levittown and settled in Huntington.

Bill Baum was an avid amateur photographer, presenting family and friends with hundreds of photos over the years. He was an active volunteer in the parish of St. Patrick's. His favorite ministry there was editing the Parish News in the 1960s.

In 2010, Bill and Rie moved to Peconic Landing in Greenport. Rie passed away the next year. Bill is survived by two brothers (John and Richard) as well as his children William ("Buzz") and his wife Geri, Christopher ("Kit"), Lucy and her husband John, and Elyse and her husband Michael; and five grandchildren, as well as many nieces and nephews. 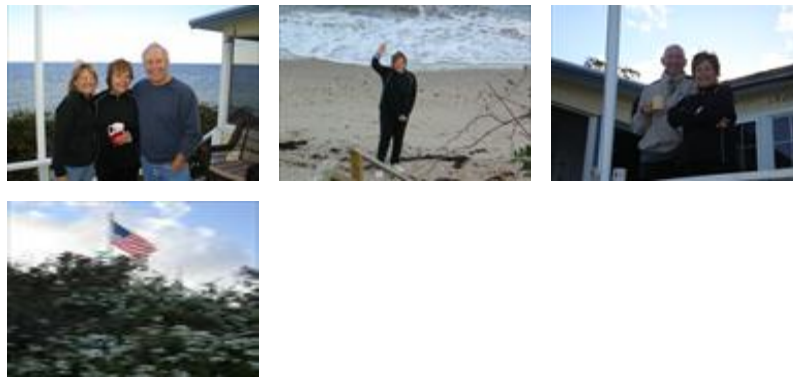
